- 4. Chairman of the Expert Committee can suggest modifications to the aforesaid composition as per the need, co-opt members for specific task and also suggest for external experts on invitation basis.
- 5. The expenditure towards TA/DA and honorarium for the meetings of the Expert Committee on non-polluting firecrackers/fireworks will be as per CSIR Rules and will be borne by CSIR initially and thereafter under the project to be implemented.
